

iPad Protection Agreement

Bedford Public Schools recognizes there is a need to protect the iPad investment by both the school district and students/families. Due to the cost of replacing and/or repairing iPads, we strongly recommend that all families purchase insurance.

We have included information about an insurance company named Worth Ave that covers iPad repair and replacement costs; however, families are free to make their own choices regarding the best way to protect their student's iPad.

Options

No Insurance: You are responsible for paying all repair and/or replacement costs out-of-pocket in a timely matter not to exceed \$550 per incident.

Insurance: You purchase an insurance policy that covers accidental damage, either through a company like Worth Ave or include the device in your homeowner's insurance policy. If the policy you choose has a deductible, you are responsible for paying the school district that amount. You are also responsible for paying the district the cost of any items that are not covered under the insurance policy not to exceed \$550 per incident.

You may purchase insurance from Worth Ave directly. Bedford students receive a 10% discount on the premium. (<https://www.worthavegroup.com/portal/bedfordhighschool>)

Bedford High School issues 32 GB 7th/8th Gen iPad models. The serial number can be found on the inventory sticker on the back of the device or by going to Settings → General → About.

By submitting your agreement electronically, you confirm the following:

- We purchased – or will purchase – insurance to cover the cost of repair and/or replacement of the iPad and understand that we are responsible for any deductibles and/or charges that are not covered under the insurance policy.
- Should we decide not to purchase insurance for the iPad, we understand that we are responsible for the entire cost of the repair and/or replacement of the iPad.
